

## Euromanager 2005 Finale

• The Global Management Challenge-Euromanager 2005! competition ended May 10 in Warsaw. Every year, national editions of this well-known business event take place in several countries. For the first time, the finale took place in Warsaw. Poland hosted the best teams from 19 countries between May 9-11. The teams that competed for the title of the best company manager came from Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, China, the Czech Republic, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, India, Italy, Macao, Mexico, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Singapore, Slovakia and Spain.

Third place went to a team of students from Spain. The Polish team, GRoM (Robert Zawit-

kowski, Łukasz Zawitkowski, Marcin Dębski and Łukasz Michałowski), was second, and first place went to a team from China.

Global Management Challenge is the biggest international project based on business simulations. More than 370,000 people from around the world have participated in it.

The competition's idea emerged 26 years ago in Portugal at the SDG company, which created an advanced strategic company management game in cooperation with lecturers from the prestigious British business school, Strathclyde University.
